Scholarship Award

The diversity scholarship award is \$15,000, which may be renewed the following year, and a paid 2013 summer position in one of the firm's domestic offices.

Eligibility

Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in an ABA-accredited law school in the JD class of 2014, must meet Finnegan's hiring criteria, and must contribute to enhancing diversity in the legal profession.

Application Process

Students must submit an application, resume, transcripts (all transcripts may be unofficial), and a 1-2 page personal statement. The personal statement should include an explanation of how the applicant has promoted diversity in his or her lifetime; how the applicant believes he or she exemplifies diversity; and how the applicant believes he or she will enhance diversity in the legal profession.
