

I. Eligibility

- 1) Candidate must be enrolled in an ABA accredited law school in the JD class of 2013: either a first-year full-time student or second-year part-time student as of April 15, 2011, and
- 2) Candidate may not be a current or past employee of Finnegan.

II. Application Requirement Checklist

- Current resume.
- Completed scholarship application (available at www.finnegan.com or your Career Development Office).
- Undergraduate and, if applicable, graduate transcripts (all transcripts may be unofficial).
- Law school transcripts (when available).
- A legal writing sample (maximum 10 pages).
- Letter(s) of recommendation. One to three from former employers or professors regarding the academic ability, character, or professional aptitude of the applicant (optional).
- Personal Statement (1-2 pages).
- A personal interview (for finalists).

III. Selection Criteria

Selection criteria include:

- 1) a demonstrated commitment to pursuing a career in intellectual property law,
- 2) exceptional academic performance at the undergraduate, graduate (if applicable), and law school level,
- 3) a degree in the life sciences, engineering, computer science, or substantial prior trademark experience,
- 4) relevant work experience, community service, leadership skills and special accomplishments.

IV. Application Deadline

A complete application must be received by **March 1, 2011**.

V. Scholarship Award

\$15,000 toward second year full-time (or third year part-time) education costs provided candidate accepts offer to join the 2012 Finnegan summer associate program. Scholarship may be renewed for the following year if scholar accepts associate offer upon successful completion of 2012 Finnegan summer associate program, maintains a grade point average of 3.0 or better in law school, and is otherwise in good standing.

Scholarship may be applied to verifiable costs associated with normal tuition, usual fees relating to enrollment status (such as, but not limited to, student activity fees, law school or university fees, and administrative fees), and a patent bar review course.
