First-Inventor-to-File (FITF) Training Plan for USPTO Examiners FY 2013 to 2014

Overview:

The USPTO is training examiners on the first-inventor-to-file provision in stages starting in March 2013 and continuing into Fiscal Year 2014. This training will take the form of videos, live lectures, a hands-on workshop, and a library of additional computer-based training (CBT) classes. Additionally, the agency has created a First-Inventor-to-File internal micro-site to house all training materials including slides, transcripts of videos, frequently asked questions, and links to the CBT classes. The agency is making all of these training materials also available to the public via the AIA micro-site.
