PROCEEDINGS: ORDER SETTING BRIEFING AND HEARING SCHEDULE  
ON DEFENDANTS' ENSNAREMENT DEFENSE (IN  
CHAMBERS)

On July 8, 2015, the duly-empaneled jury in this case delivered its special verdict, finding in favor of Plaintiff G. David Jang, M.D. Specifically, the jury found that Plaintiff met his burden of proof that as to Claims 1 and 8 of U.S. Patent 5,922,021, the Defendants' Express stents "met the requirement(s) under the doctrine of equivalents." See Doc. No. 661.

After directing the Clerk to enter the jury's verdict into the record, the Court reminded counsel for both parties of its prior ruling that in the event the jury found in favor of Plaintiff under the doctrine of equivalents theory, it would proceed with an evidentiary hearing on the issue of ensnarement. Although the Court sought the agreement of the parties regarding a date for the evidentiary hearing, no such

stipulation or agreement has arrived.

Therefore, the Court sets the following schedule:

- The evidentiary hearing on the issue of ensnarement is set for Tuesday, August 18, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.

- Any additional briefing by either party on the issues to be heard and determined at the evidentiary hearing shall be filed no later than Thursday, August 6, 2015. The briefs shall not exceed 25 pages, not including tables of contents and authorities, and attachments.
