Pursuant to the Court's Order filed 07/29/08 and the Jury's Verdict, entered on December 11, 2007, the following judgment is entered: The Court finds that Defendant Gore has not proven by clear and convincing evidence that Dr. Goldfarb and/or his attorneys committed inequitable conduct during the prosecution of U.S. Patent No. 6,436,135. In addition, Plaintiffs are entitled to damages for lost profits in the amount of \$102,081,578.82 and are further entitled to royalty damages in the amount of \$83,508,292.20.
