

ORDER

For the reasons discussed in the accompanying Memorandum  
Opinion, it is, this *31st* day of October, 2013, ORDERED that:

1. The Plaintiff's motion to reopen this case, vacate summary judgment, and to dismiss claims related to U.S. Patent No. 6,219,674 ("patent 674") (ECF No. 204), BE, and HEREBY IS, GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART:
  - a. The Plaintiff's motion to reopen this case is GRANTED--the stay on this case is LIFTED;
  - b. The Plaintiff's motion to vacate summary judgment is DENIED;
  - c. The Plaintiff's motion to dismiss is GRANTED, except it is DENIED as to Defendant's unenforceability counterclaim as to patent 674 (ECF No. 119 at 8); and
