

Judge F. Dennis Saylor, IV: "Plaintiffs' Motion to Amend the Judgment (Docket No. 813) is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part. Paragraphs 5 and 7 of the judgment will be amended as requested by plaintiffs to correct the clerical errors identified in the motion. Plaintiffs' request to amend the judgment to modify Paragraphs 6 and 8 to add references to "foreign counterpart" patents is denied. Based on the evidentiary record before the court, and in light of substantial questions of jurisdiction, the court declines to amend the judgment as requested. The proposed language does not identify the foreign patents at issue. Furthermore, it is unclear at best how the court would be able to interpret those foreign patents in the event of a dispute, and enforce alleged violations of a judgment that referred to those foreign patents. An amended judgment consistent with this order will enter separately." ELECTRONIC ORDER entered granting in part and denying in part 813 Motion to Alter Judgment.
