PERMANENT INJUNCTION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Holland L.P. (“Holland”) and its present and future successors, assigns, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and persons in active concert or participation with them, including any affiliated entities (all of said individuals and entities being referred to herein as “Enjoined Parties”) are **ENJOINED** from infringing, directly or indirectly, or inducing the infringement of claim 16 of U.S. Patent No. 7,616,329 (the “ ’329 Patent”). Specifically, Enjoined Parties are **ENJOINED** from manufacturing, importing, using, selling, and/or offering for sale in the United States any product or system having the ability to detect misaligned or sunken tie plates in accordance with claim 16 of the ’329 Patent. This injunction includes, but is not limited to, products and/or systems provided to Holland by Rail Vision, Ltd., such as the Rail Vision Line Scan System and the Rail Vision Laser Plate-Cutting System adjudged to have infringed the ’329 Patent (collectively, the “Rail Vision Systems”) and variations thereof (whether or not related to Rail Vision, Ltd.) not more than colorably different. Further, Enjoined Parties are immediately **ENJOINED** from manufacturing,


importing, using, selling, and/or offering for sale in the United States any of the Rail Vision Systems.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within ten (10) business days of the entry of this Order, Holland shall provide notice of this Permanent Injunction to all suppliers, distributors, customers, and other third parties who have: (1) ordered, received, leased, or purchased the Rail Vision Systems from Holland; (2) received services from Holland using the Rail Vision Systems; or (3) supplied the Rail Vision Systems to Holland.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Enjoined Parties shall not advertise the Rail Vision Systems and any such references thereto should be immediately removed from Holland's marketing materials and websites.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within fifteen (15) business days of the entry of this Order, Holland shall file with the Court, and serve on all parties to this action, a notice stating the names and addresses of each party that Holland has notified in compliance with this Order.
