MINUTE entry before the Honorable Amy J. St. Eve: The Court finds that: (1) Mylan failed to prove by clear and convincing evidence that claims 1–3, 7–10, and 17 of the 727 patent are invalid or unenforceable; and (2) Mylan's proposed bivalirudin drug product infringes claims 1, 7–10, and 17 of the 727 patent as a matter of law under Sunovion. Accordingly, the Court enters judgment in favor of TMC on its infringement claim regarding the 727 patent and on Mylan's counterclaims regarding claims 1–3, 7–10, and 17.
