**ORDER OF COURT RE: PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO COMPEL INITIAL  
DISCLOSURE DOCUMENTS (DOC. NO. 41)**

Presently before this Court is Plaintiff's Motion to Compel, in which Plaintiff moves this Court to order that Defendants produce information pursuant to Local Patent Rule 3.1. Doc. No. 41. Defendants oppose this Motion. Doc. No. 43. After consideration of the Motion and related documents, including Defendants' brief in opposition, the Court finds that Plaintiff's Motion should be granted. Defendants shall produce all source code, specifications, schematics, flow charts, or other technical documentation relating to the operation of the accused products (Parrot's AR.Drone, AR.Drone 2.0, MiniDrone, and Bebop Drone) and any associated remote-controlled software applications, including all versions and drafts of Defendants' FreeFlight software app on or before July 9, 2014.
