ORDER

This cause is before the Court on Defendant's Motions for Judgment as a Matter of Law, Motion for New Trial, and Motion for Remittiture of Damages. (Doc. 330). The Plaintiff has responded to Defendant's motions. (Doc. 346). The Court has reviewed the pleadings, and pertinent trial testimony.

Defendant contends a reasonable jury could not conclude the LMU-3000 and 3050 directly infringe the '885 and '278 patents. Defendant also argues the verdict lacks evidentiary support and was "infected by serious and prejudicial errors at trial," including that Plaintiff's expert testified beyond the scope of his disclosed opinion and that Plaintiff's counsel invited the jury to disregard the claim construction. Finally, Defendant argues the evidence does not support a royalty of \$5 per unit. The Court finds these arguments to lack merit.

Upon due consideration Defendant's Motions are **DENIED**.
