**THIS MATTER** having been brought before the Court on an application for emergency relief and a preliminary injunction pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65 and L. Civ. R. 65.1 (ECF no. 70); and the court having granted temporary restraints for a total of 28 days (ECF nos. 78, 104); and the court having held a preliminary injunction hearing on June 28, 2018; upon review of the written submissions, evidence, and oral argument;

**IT IS THIS** 13th day of July, 2018,

**ORDERED** as follows:

1. The motion of plaintiffs for a preliminary injunction (ECF no. 70) is GRANTED.
2. The restraints contained in the temporary restraining orders (ECF nos. 78, 104) shall continue in effect pending the entry of a final form of order of preliminary injunction.

3. On or before Monday, July 16, 2018, the parties shall submit an agreed form of preliminary injunction, including an order that appropriate security be posted, or shall separately submit proposed forms of order on which the Court will rule.
